

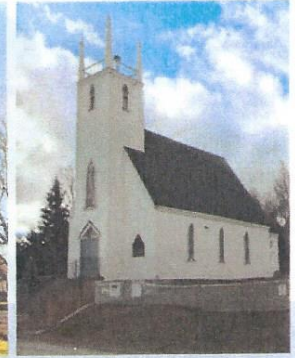
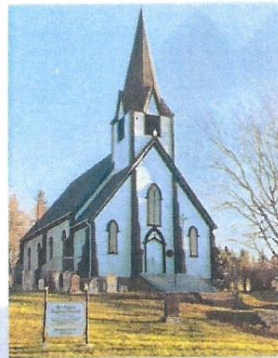

We were again able to have Winter Church in the Parish Hall from Epiphany to Palm Sunday.

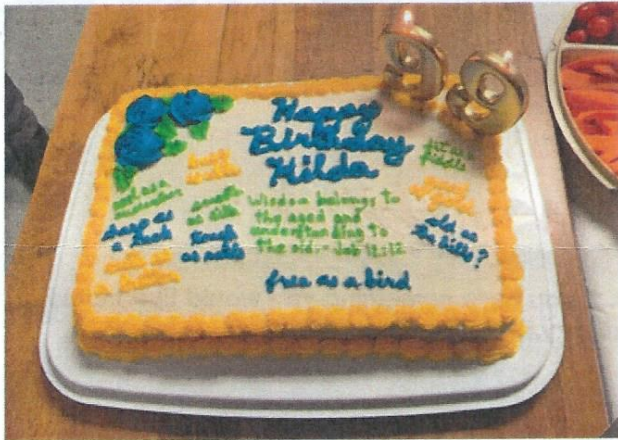

A very special birthday...

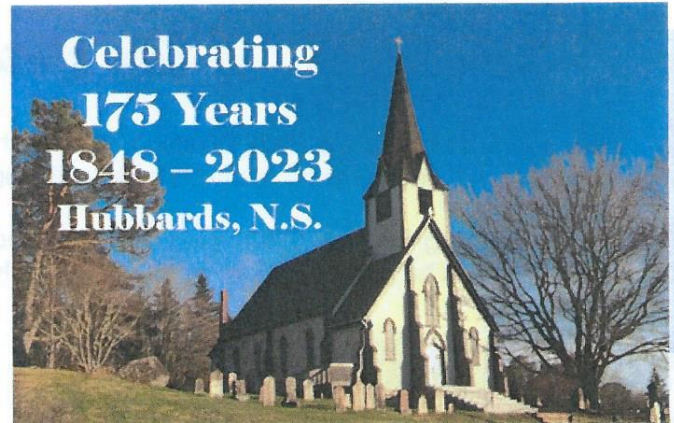
